

Common Council Meeting Minutes
August 9, 2011

Mayor Knuth called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Roll Call: Myhre, Krueger, Helgerson, and Kennedy. Mendum – absent.

Krueger/Helgerson to approve Minutes from July 12, 2011 and July 26, 2011. All ayes: carried.

Myhre/Krueger to approve Mayor's appointment of Pat Kennedy to the CDBG Housing Committee. All ayes: carried.

Bob Retzlaff, owner of Willow Pond Trailer Park provided a status update on compliance with City ordinances pursuant to last year's inspection and indicated he will provide notification to the City in his decision to either demolish or trailer #8.

Royall School District Superintendent Mark Gruen inquired about the status of the School moving the scoreboard and fence to the new sports complex site. Information was provided re: original agencies involved in purchasing and constructing the scoreboard. Gruen will research the matter and return with additional information.

Larry Rawn and members of the Museum Board presented a list of necessary repairs for the Museum Building.

Representatives of the 3 local bars presented their September Street dance proposal involving temporary closing off of 80/82 from Franklin St. to Elroy St. Council provided conditional approval for the event and will officially approve any necessary permits at the September Council meeting.
