  - a) Consideration of the discontinuance of a portion of Elroy Street, to wit: A part of Elroy Street located between Assessor's Lot 152 of the City of Elroy on the north side and Assessor's Lot 151 of the City of Elroy on the South side, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the Southwest corner of Assessor's Lot 152 of the City of Elroy and the North line of Elroy Street; thence Northeasterly along the North line of Elroy Street to the Northeast corner of the NE1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 33, Township 15, Rang 2 East; thence South along the East line of said Ne!4, SW1/4 of Section 33 to a point which is the Northwest corner of Lot 1 Block 1 of Messinger's Addition to the City of Elroy and the South line of Elroy Street; thence Southwesterly along the South right-of-way line of Elroy Street to the intersection with the Northwest corner of Assessor's Lot 151 of the City of Elroy; thence Northerly to the point of beginning.
    - a. Discussion and possible action on Resolution Number 963, the vacating/discontinuance of a portion of Elroy Street (east of South Brooklyn and West of a portion that begins 250-ft west of Grove Avenue.
