Pledge of Allegiance

Madden/Peterson motion to approve the minutes from June 9, 2020. All ayes. Carried.

Mayor called to order a public hearing to discuss an application from Neil Nemitz for a Conditional Use Permit to allow him to construct a 30ft X 40ft building on his property at N3260 County Rd P.

Schroeder/Lindemann motion to deny a petition for a shooting range on a private property within city limits. Roll call 4-ayes, 1-nay. Motion carried.

Lindemann/Madden motion to deny a property damage claim at 117 S. Main Street. Roll call. All ayes. Carried.

Lindemann/Schroeder motion to follow the new pool pricing as presented with an addition of a \$50.00 daycare season pass for residents and non-residents, and will also continue with the punch card. All ayes. Carried.

Huber/Lindemann authorize Tony to contact the D.O.T. to ask about lowering the speed limit going out of town to the park.

Introduction of Ordinance #432 to amend the existing ATV/UTV ordinance to allow travel on all city streets.

Introduction of Ordinance #433 to allow golf carts to operate on city streets.

Lindemann/Huber motion to approve Resolution #1090-EDA Disaster Grant Application. Roll call. All ayes. Carried.

Update on property issues. Western Ave property is gone. Mattresses left behind are property owner's responsibility. 317 Academy was given a deadline of July 21<sup>st</sup> to have area filled in or citations will be issued. Council members should make a list of blighted homes in their ward to be presented at the next meeting.

Madden/Huber motion to approve the expenditures. Roll call. All ayes. Carried.
