## Streets Projects:

- Spray weeds along Main Street and in Museum garden along gravel walkways, as well as City Hall and the Powerhouse
- Replace decking on Burn Site bridge and monitor for settlement - DONE
- Cross walk and curb painting – DONE; City Hall parking lot painting, handicap paint by Museum
- Ackerman ditch regrading
- Finish CTH O driveways
- Patch Museum roof
- Install No Parking signs by high school baseball diamond
- Install concrete pads around welcome signs, wishing well, picnic table, and other spots (similar to concrete pads placed around fire pits at Park).
- Put No Parking signs near Pool (to keep people from parking on the grass).
- Grading at cemetery
- Potholes at entrance to Picha Funeral Home and at entrance to Mile Bluff Clinic
- Clean-Up at Park in preparation for the Fair
