Brent from Lenorud Services spoke about the garbage bid and explained why the bid increased so much. GPS installed on all trucks, average tonnage has increased, actually make 451 stops, not the 320 we had been paying for previously, they now have to pay to have recycling taken. Council discussed ways to offset price increase. Possibly increase tag price, re-vamp Spring clean up. Asked Brent to give us ideas of how other communities do their garbage and recycling billing. Carole and Lynn to look into options and present at November meeting.

Lindemann/Madden made a motion to approve the bid from Lenorud services for \$34,095.60 for refuse and \$22,730.40 for recycling. Roll Call. All ayes. Carried.

City Administrator Brown gave presentation on 2019 budget.
